All the Teachers working in the University are requested to submit their proposals for annual API scores through the respective committees constituted vide University order No.BBA/IQAC/2015 dated 15th June, 2015 to the Coordinator, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Dr. PDKV, Akola in the enclosed proformae along with self attested copies of verifiable documents / records for verification.

The incumbents should submit their proposal as per following instructions.

- 1. The proposal should be submitted strictly in the enclosed proformas. The proposal should be submitted for every year separately e.g. 2009-10 (Cat. I, II & III), 2010-11 (Cat. I, II & III), onward along with summery sheet for all the three categories at the beginning of the proposal and only category III for entire period prior to 1st July 2009.
- 2. No variation should be made in the proforma at their own level.
- 3. The proposal should be submitted for every academic year starting with 1st July to 30th June. The incumbents will have to submit the proposal for preceding academic year before the 31st July of current academic year (viz. the proposal for 2015-16 should be submitted before 31st July, 2016 and so on and so forth).
- 4. The API system is applicable w.e.f. 1st July, 2009.
- 5. The incumbent should first arrange the documents chronologically within each sub group and Category. The proposal should be submitted with due indexing, paging, with separators and in hard bound copy. The committee will not be responsible for misplacement of loose papers in the proposals.
- **6.** It will be the responsibility of the incumbent to submit the proposal in proper format and in time so that it will be scrutinized by the respective scrutiny committees.
- 7. The dates of academic year should be adhered to very strictly considering Sr.No. 1 & 3 above.
- **8.** Proper precautions should be taken while attaching single certificate for same activity sought for more than one year, then that certificate should be enclosed in respective yearwise proposal highlighting the year.
- 9. Only the certificates issued by the respective competent authority will be considered for assessment. Self-certified documents will not be considered.

- 10. In case of research publications / books / chapters / conference papers/ online publications etc., cover page of the respective publications should also be enclosed along with reprints to verify ISSN / ISBN Nos.
- 11. For claiming the marks in respect of courses taught and student guided and other teaching activities, etc.the certificate issued by the respective competent authority or relevant evidence will be considered.
- 12. For claiming the marks in respect of research related activities like recommendations, variety released, patents, project handled etc. the certificate issued by the respective competent authority or relevant evidence will be considered.
- 13. For claiming the marks in respect of extension related activities like kisanmela, farmersfield visit, Diagnostic field visit, etc. the certificate issued by the respective competent authority or relevant evidence will be considered.
