The question paper will contain 200 questions having total 200 Marks for 2 hrs.

The question paper of 200 Marks will consist of following subjects.

5	Junior Engineer (Civil) (Degree/Diploma)	100 questions	100 Marks

The standard for the written test will be equivalent to diploma level. The medium of examination will be English except Marathi Subject. The nature of question paper will be as per given below.

1. Marathi :- 25 Marks

The Standard of questions of Marathi subject will be equivalent to higher secondary school examination (XII standard) which will include Grammer, Sentences, and usages of words.

2. English:- 25 Marks

The subject will include Spelling, English grammer, English Transformation, Sentences and use of works, Vocabulary of higher secondary school examination (XII standard).

3.General Knowledge :- 25 Marks

The subject will include day to day events, experiences, religion, Indian constitution & politics, Science & Technology, Social and Industrial reforms, Literature & Culture, Sports & Games, History & Geography of India including Maharashtra, Renowed (Great) Personalities and their contribution, Administration and rural development, Indian Economy.

4. Aptitude Test:- 25 Marks

In order to judge ability and promptness of the candidate in giving correct answers.

5. Junior Engineer (Civil)/(Degree/Diploma).

100 questions will be asked on the basis of syllabus of Civil Engineer (Diploma).

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
