Search Committee invites applications for the post of Vice-Chancellor

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krishi Vidyapeeth, Akola is one of the four Agricultural Universities in Maharashtra to cater the needs of teaching, research and extension education in agriculture and allied sectors of the Vidarbha region. The jurisdiction of the University extends to the area comprising the revenue divisions of Amravati and Nagpur having 11 districts. The University has 6 constituent Colleges and 2 affiliated Colleges. Apart from this, the University also has 21 private Agricultural Colleges. The University offers graduate and post graduate degree courses including Doctoral Degree Programmes and also conducts diploma courses through its constituent and affiliated colleges and agricultural schools. The University carries out the research work through its 19 Research Stations.

Chancellor and Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra have formed a three Member Search Committee for recommending suitable names for the post of Vice-Chancellor.
