#### APPENDIX I

# Terms and Conditions governing Trinocular Research Microscope with photographic and computer attachment

#### Part-I

- 1. Tenders received late in person/ by post will not be considered. In case tenders are sent by Registered post, it shall be the responsibility of intending supplier to ensure that they are received before closing hours.
- 2. The tenders are proposed to be opened on 10/11/2015 at 11.00 hours in office of the Officer In-charge, AICRP on Fruit, Dr. PDKV., Akola in the presence of the intending supplier who may desires to attend.
- 3. The rates both in words and figures without any corrections or overwriting should be quoted in Appendix-II for each individual item separately. Any overwriting or rewriting should be duly countersigned. The rates must be valid up to SIX MONTH from the date of execution of Agreement.
- 4. The intending supplier shall also have to mention the name of manufacturer/ Authorization certification, make, model of the microscope and has to enclose the pamphlets/ pictures of the appliances offered, for which the rates are quoted. In the absence of the above, the items offered will not be considered. The preference will be given to (a) Manufactures, (b) Authorized Reseller or dealer of overseas manufacturer,(c) Authorized Dealer of manufacturers (d) Supplier.
- 5. University will accept the tender for items mentioned in Appendix II from only (a)Manufacturer (b) Authorized Reseller or dealer of overseas manufacturers (c) Authorized Dealers of manufacturers and (d) any other agency, which is having adequate experience for Trinocular Research Microscope with Photographic and computer attachment Such agencies must enclose adequate documents to prove their claims. - 7. The University reserves the right to accept or reject the items of the make other than the above.
- 8. Tenderer may enclose published report of comparative study of his quoted items, which will give additional weight age to his quoted price
- 9. The tenderer should quote the rates only in Appendix II of the tender issued by this office and not on any other form.
- 10. The tenderer should submit his offer in two separate envelopes

- 12. - 13. The intending supplier should quote the rates inclusive of all expenses, charges, taxes, duties, transportation, packing and forwarding, insurance etc., i.e. All 'Inclusive 'with free delivery at respective offices of the University as mentioned in Appendix-II. However, the Octroi will be over and above this, if applicable. The equipment's will have to be supplied as per the specification within TWO WEEKS or as per the last date mentioned in final supply order.

- 14. University will reserve full rights to open/ consider the second envelop if and only if University is satisfied with information contained in envelope no.1. The decision of the University regarding this will be final and shall be binding on tenderer.
- 15. The supplier will have to supply in full or in part the articles to different offices as mentioned in Appendix-II and any other office of the University located anywhere in Vidarbha region till date of validity of rates
- 16. If the Trinocular Research Microscope with photographic and computer attachment are not provided within stipulated time limits, deduction @1% of the total cost of order value per week for extra time taken and will be deducted from the bill. However, the Vice-chancellor, Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh Krishi Vidyapeeth, Akola may condone/ relax this penalty and may grant extension up to the time limit as deemed to be fit by him, provided the tenderer applies and satisfies about genuineness of the reasons for delay in supply of articles
- 17. The tenderer shall have to deposit Earnest Money Deposit (E.M.D.) 1% in cash or through Demand Draft drawn on State Bank of India, Dr. PDKV., Branch (Branch No. 2171), payable to Officer In-charge AICRP on Fruits, Dr. PDKV., Akola and the same should be enclosed along with the tender. The tender without E.M.D. will not be considered at all. The amount of E.M.D will be refunded in case of unsuccessful tenderer on submission of plain application with Money Receipt in original soon after the final decision. In case of successful tenderer, it will be deemed as partial payment towards 3% of Security Deposit.
- 18. The specimen of 'Agreement Bond' will be provided along with letter of acceptance to the tenderer whose rates are accepted by the University. The tenderer shall have to execute agreement in this prescribed form on Government Court Fee Stamp paper costing to Rs. 100/-, which should be submitted to this office within, specified time. The agreement received under seal and signature of tenderer will become legal agreement between the tenderer and the University, which will be binding on tenderer.
- 19. If the successful tenderer fails to comply with the supply order within the specified period or only part supply is made, the Officer In-charge, AICRP on Fruits, Dr. PDKV., Akola or competent authority or any officer authorized by him/ them, will arrange for the expenses of the said tenderer, who shall have to bear and pay all additional expenditure incurred by the University in that behalf
- 20. Successful tenderer will have to furnish security deposit to the extent of 3% of total cost of the items accepted by the University as offered in the tender either in cash or through demand draft drawn on SBI, Dr. PDKV branch No. 2171 Akola in favor of

- 21. The amount of security deposit without any interest there on will be returned to the tenderer after 12 months or the expiry of the warranty period whichever is late from date of supply. Subject to the surrender of Money Receipt in original in this office

The right to enhance or reduce the quantity of any tendered item and right to accept/ reject whole or part of any tender, without assigning any reason, whatsoever, is reserved by this University. - 23. On acceptance of the rates as per the approved tender and after completing official necessary formalities, the tenderer will be informed about the acceptance of his tender. - 24. As soon as the tenderer delivers the tender in the office of the undersigned, it shall be binding on him and he shall not be able to withdraw or amend the offer.
