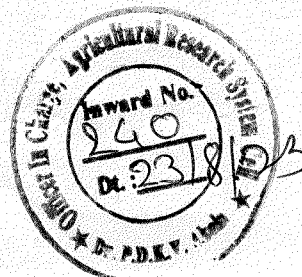

**I. Name of the Award :** Best Agricultural Research Station/Project Award

### **II. Objectives :**

- i. To recognize outstanding performance of Agricultural Research Station/Project.
- ii. To provide incentive for outstanding research station/project performance.
- iii. To promote a sense of institutional pride in achievements

**III. Nature of the Award:** Annual award consists of Rs. 1,00,000/- in cash, a citation and a plaque for Research Station/ Project. The award money will be utilized for strengthening of Research Station/ Project.

**IV. Conferring of Award:** Award will be conferred on the University Foundation Day (20<sup>th</sup> October).

### **V. Eligibility Criteria**

1. All the Agricultural Research Stations / projects in Dr. PDKV Jurisdiction are eligible.
2. Submission of application form is compulsory for all the research stations/projects for award and ranking.
3. The station should submit AUC and annual reports to the office of DOR, Dr. PDKV, Akola or its equivalent competent authority. Non submission of the document will adversely affect the ranking.
4. The stations/ projects with pending documents (ATR, QPR, MPR, Ranking Information, Website Information, any other important information etc) concerned to the Directorate of Research will adversely affect the ranking.

### **VI. Evaluation Criteria**

- i. Documentary evidence certified by the Controlling Officer must be provided for every claim.
- ii. Attach self-attested documentary evidence for each mark claimed as well as wherever necessary.
- iii. A separate committee will be constituted at the University level for evaluation.

#### III. Nature of the Award: Annual award consists of a citation and Rs. 25,000/- cash prize.

#### IV. Conferring of Award: Award will be conferred on the University Foundation Day (20<sup>th</sup> October).

#### V. Eligibility Criteria

- i. The applicant must have at least five years experience in Dr. PDKV, Akola
- ii. The scientist with regular establishment in Dr. PDKV, Akola and working in the research station / project of the university is eligible for the award.
- iii. The existing Directors/ Associate Deans/ Head of the Departments /Associate Directors of Research shall not apply for the award.
- iv. The “applicant” must have not less than “Very good” annual appraisal reports for immediate past five reports.
- v. Documentary evidence for the marks claimed should be enclosed.
- vi. He/She should not be penalized through the enquiry
- vii. The award-winning scientist will not be eligible to apply for the award for next five years.
- viii. Information for last five years should be given from year 2018-19 to 2022-23.

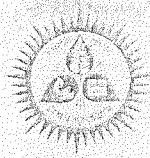
