- e) The prices shall be quoted in Indian Rupees only.

4. Each bidder shall submit only one quotation.

5. Validity of Quotation

Quotation shall remain valid for a period not less than 15 days after deadline date specified for submission.

6. Evaluation of Quotations

The Purchaser will evaluate and compare the quotations determined to be substantially responsive i.e. which

- a) Are properly signed; and
- b) Conform to the terms and conditions, and specifications.

7. Award of contract
